

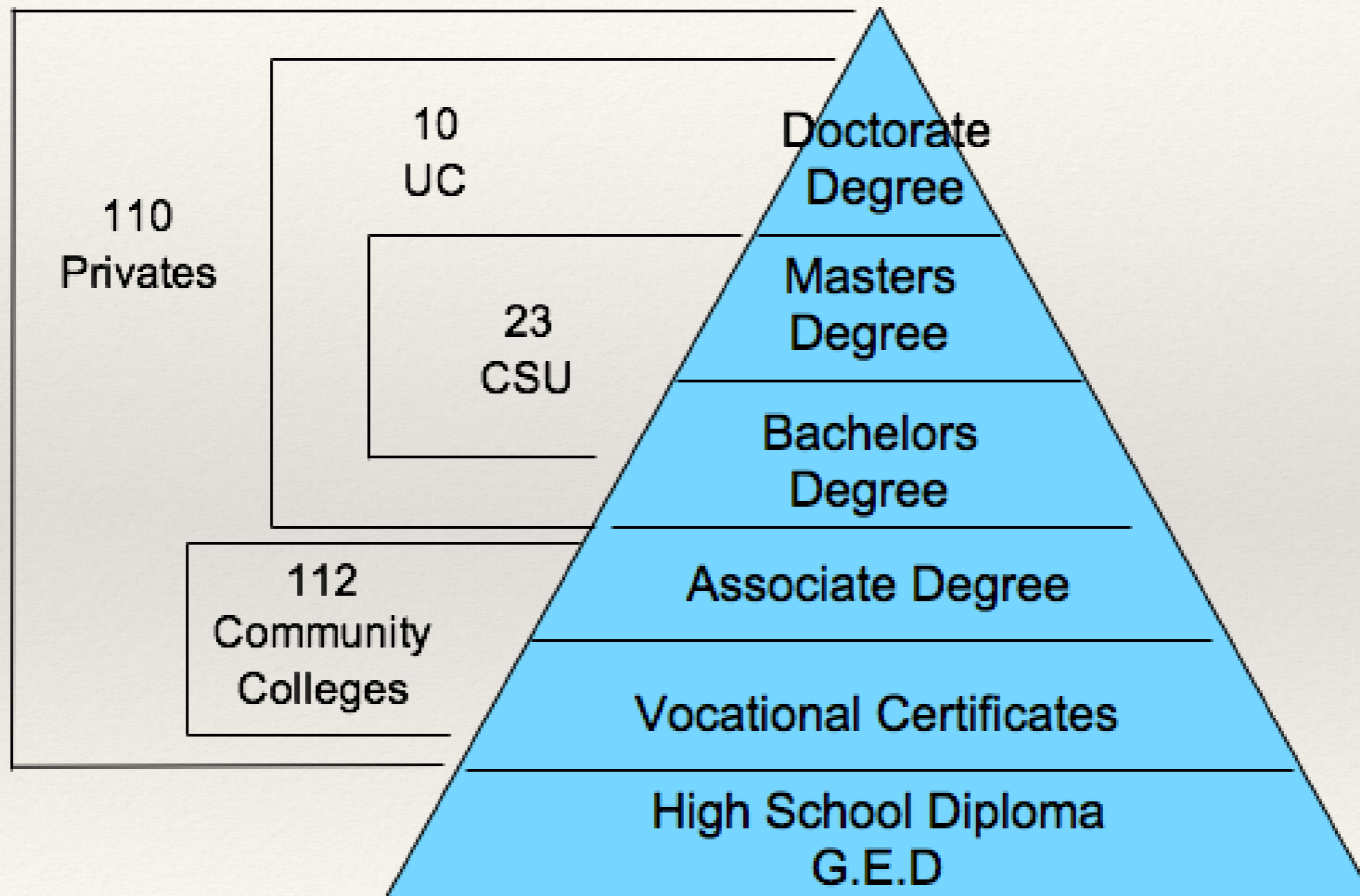

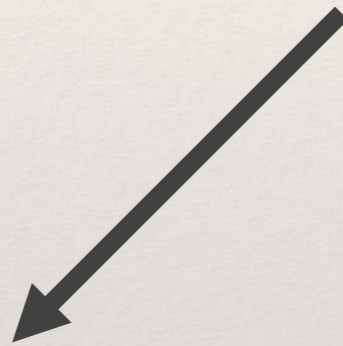

Pathway to a University

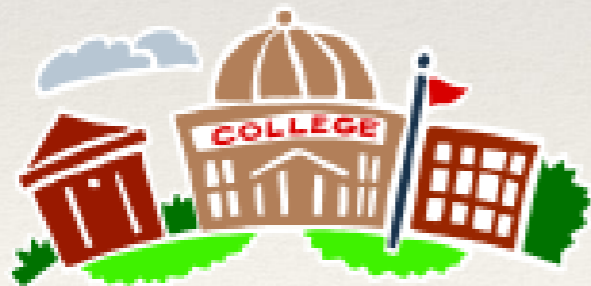

Attend 2-3 years, complete transfer requirements, then transfer to the university to finish junior and senior years.

Community College

Programs & Curriculum	Two-Year School <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Career and Job Preparation• Various Majors• Transfer Programs• AA/AS Degrees• Vocational Certificates
Cost	\$46.00 a unit \$1,104 a year
Entrance Requirements	Must be at least 18 years-old or have obtained a high school diploma or GED
Test/Essay Requirements	No test or essay required

A-G Requirements For Admission

A. History/Social Science - 2 years

B. English-4 years

C. Mathematics- 3 years (4 recommended starting with Algebra 1)

D. Laboratory Science- 2 years (including at least two of the three core disciplines of biology, chemistry and physics)

E. Languages other than English- 2 years (3 recommended)

F. Visual/Performing Arts- 1 year (Dance, Theater, Art, etc.)

G. College Preparatory Electives- 1 year (From the following subject areas: History, English, Advanced Mathematics, Laboratory Science, Foreign Language, Social Science, and Visual/Performing Arts)

Test/Essay Requirements	In most cases SAT I or ACT, check with individual schools for specific test requirements

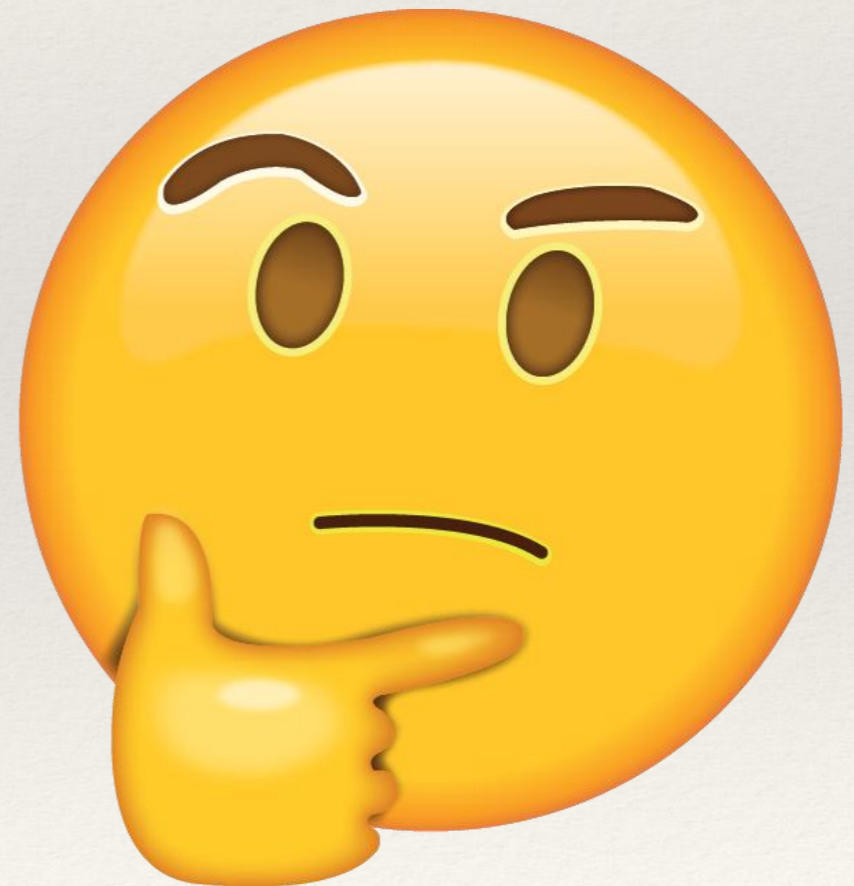

College Advice for High School Students

All community colleges have programs in which high school students are able to earn college units towards a bachelors or associates degree. High school students DO NOT have to pay the \$46 per unit fee! These classes can be used at Community Colleges, Cal State, UC, or Private Universities.

College Advice for Undocumented Students

- ❖ If you have completed at least three years at a California high school, then you may be an AB540 student, therefore:
 - ❖ You do not have to provide your college with a SSN, or a State ID
 - ❖ Colleges will provide an affidavit for you to complete so that you are charged in-state tuition.
- ❖ There are scholarships and state aid available for AB540 students

- ❖ Do your personal insight questions early
- ❖ Have your options ready by the time you start applying
